## Pugh Centre Move-In Logistics

Dear Residents and Guarantors of Pugh Centre,

It's hard to believe that move-in day is only a few days away! I hope you are as excited as we are about the upcoming lease term and your new home-away-from-home!

We have updated our logistics for the move-in process at Pugh Centre and will be implementing traffic control and designated unloading areas to assist in moving in.


On August 23, 2025, from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, there will be a dedicated traffic flow beginning at the corner of Pugh Street and Highland Alley, with dedicated 10-minute unloading spots, before exiting via "A Alley". Please use your time in the unloading zone to strictly remove belongings from your vehicle and pile them on the sidewalk. Move-In Assistants will be available to help bring your belongings up to your apartment. *These Move-In Assistants will graciously accept cash tips!* Please be courteous to other residents moving in and do not hold up the line. Depending on traffic, a second turn in an unloading zone may be possible, if you loop back around to Pugh St, but a second turn is not guaranteed.

Once your time in an unloading zone is complete, you must park at a location other than Pugh Centre. Below, please find some nearby public parking suggestions. Please note we cannot guarantee availability at these locations, and it is not an all-encompassing list of public parking Downtown.

- Pugh Street Garage 126 S Pugh St, State College, PA 16801
- Allen Street Metered Lot 233S S Allen St, State College, PA 16801
- Beaver Avenue Lot accessible from W Beaver Ave on the 100 block across from Kelly Alley
- McAllister St. Parking Deck 132 McAllister St, State College, PA 16801

If you have a parking agreement for a parking space on-site at Pugh Centre, please be sure to have a copy of your parking agreement with you, especially for those assigned a space in the upper deck accessible via Highland Alley. The traffic control team has been instructed to validate this agreement before allowing tenants into the deck. Those with a parking space in the lower deck will access the deck from Beaver Avenue and will not need to interact with the traffic flow explained above.

On the last page of this document, and below, please find a diagram that shows the flow of traffic for move-in. The maroon arrows indicate that you will begin with a right turn onto Pugh St until you come to the intersection with Highland Alley (the stop sign). There, a traffic controller will direct you either to an unloading zone or to wait until one becomes available. Please be courteous and follow their instructions. The striped arrow shows the location of the unloading zones, which will be along the sidewalk on the Pugh Centre side of the alley. Please leave space for opening trunks between you and a neighboring vehicle. After your 10 minutes is up, please proceed down Highland Alley (green arrows) until you come to a traffic controller who will alert you to turn onto A Alley. This will take you to Foster Ave. Once you are at the intersection of A Alley and Foster Ave, you are free to go in whichever direction you would like to find a more permanent parking location in an available public lot.
